Bio:

Anton Harber has been a journalist for 40 years, as a reporter, editor, manager, educator/trainer, columnist and commentator. He runs two non-profit organisations: the *Campaign for Free Expression* and the *Henry Nxumalo Foundation* (which supports investigative reporting). He holds the Caxton Chair of Journalism at Wits University as an adjunct professor, is chair of Africa Check and a board member of the Global Investigative Journalism Network (GIJN) and the Centre for Collaborative Investigative Journalism (CCIJ). He was founder-editor of the anti-apartheid newspaper *The Weekly Mail / Mail & Guardian* and Editor-in-Chief of the country's leading TV news station, eNCA. He has written or edited a number of books, including *So, for the Record: Behind the headlines in an era of state capture*. (2020, Jonathan Ball) *Diepsloot* (2011, Jonathan Ball) and *Southern African Muckrakers: 300 years of investigative reporting that shaped the region* (2019, Jacana).
