Dr Mandira Bagwandeem has experience working with think tanks, local and international corporate companies, and lecturing at universities in South Africa. She is a Senior Research Fellow at the Nelson Mandela School of Public Governance at the University of Cape Town (UCT), where her research focuses on Africa's regional integration and industrialisation and China-Africa relations. Mandira is affiliated with several local and international think tanks, including the Foreign Policy Research Institute (US), the African Studies Centre at Metropolitan University Prague (Czech Republic), the Afro-Sino Centre of International Relations (Ghana), NTU-SBF Centre for African Studies (Singapore), the African Centre for the Study of the US at University of the Witwatersrand (South Africa). Mandira often provides commentary for various local and international media outlets and has published several academic and opinion articles. Her recent co-authored article titled 'African Agency, COVID-19 and Debt Renegotiations with China' was published in the *South African Journal of International Affairs*; her co-edited book titled *Africa's Railway Renaissance: The Role and Impact of China* was released in July 2023. It was produced with two prominent Stellenbosch University colleagues Dr Tim Zajontz and Prof Anthony Leysens.
