Bio: Professor Dr Ingrid Schneider is Professor of Political Science in the Department of Informatics at Universität Hamburg, Germany. Her research fields are technology assessment, governance, law, economy and ethics of IT and AI on which she has published numerous publications. Since 1996, she has advised several institutions, including the European Parliament and the European Commission, and has acted as a Board Member of various European Scientific Associations and Research Projects. Her current research project is "PRODIGEES- Promoting Research on Digitalization in Emerging Powers and Europe Towards Sustainable Development" (2020-2025, EU funded). In this context, she studied the perspective of the Global South on the digital transformation and its governance in Mexico, Brazil and India. She has recently conducted field research in South Africa and will report on her results.
