Andrzej Polus (PhD) is the former president of the Polish Center for African Studies. His research work focuses on the political economy of hydrocarbons management and the current political situation in Sub-Saharan Africa. In his work, he also looks for paradoxes in international relations theories. He has participated – as principal investigator or co-investigator – in 15 research projects devoted to development studies in Sub-Saharan Africa, and conducted field research in Angola, Botswana, Ghana, Namibia, South Africa, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia, and Zimbabwe. He lectures both in Polish and English.
